

Declaration Under Section 21 of The Firearms Act

1968

It is an offence for any person who is prohibited by section 21 of the firearms act 1968 to have a firearms or ammunition in his/her possession at any time.

This section applies to any person who has been sentenced to imprisonment or to youth custody or detention in any young offender's institution for three months or more.

The period for which they are prohibited depends on the length of their sentence.

If the sentence was longer than three years, the prohibition is for life.

If the sentence was three months or more but less than three years, the prohibition lasts for five years from the date of their release.

It is an offence for a person to transfer, let or hire, give or lend a firearm or ammunition to someone whom he/she knows has reasonable grounds for believing to be prohibited by Section 21.

I hereby declare that I have read the above and have never had a firearms or shotgun application refused or such a certificate revoked. I also declare that I am not a person prohibited by virtue of section 21 of The Firearms Act 1968.
